

The Sisterhood of the Traveling Pants 2 follows up on the popular 2005 film about four best friends who share everything, including the famous pair of jeans that magically fits all their physiques. Now off to college-and facing more-grown-up dilemmas—the quartet of BFFs is portrayed by the same actresses, including Gilmore Girls' Alexis Bledel and Ugly Betty's America Ferrera. Political incorrectness has never been as hilarious as in Tropic Thunder, the story of a big-budget war movie whose actors blunder off the set and into real-life danger zones. Ben Stiller has assembled a cast of comic genius, including Jack Black, Steve Coogan and himself, of course, but the biggest roars come courtesy of Robert Downey Jr. Woody Allen's latest film. Vicky Cristina Barcelona, plunges into erotic terrain not usually associated with the neurotic New Yorker. It's the story of two tourists who travel to Spain: uptight Vicky (Rebecca Hall) and adventurous Cristina (Scarlett Johansson).
