In *No Reservations*, she's a tyrannical gourmet chef forced to defrost her heart after becoming the legal guardian of her young niece Zoe (*Little Miss Sunshine* charmer **Abigail Breslin**). This being a romcom, there's a hunk hanging around the kitchen to push the "defrost" button: in this case, it's **Aaron Eckhart** (*Thank You for Smoking*) showing his warmer, gentler side. ● *Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix*, the fifth instalment of this increasingly riveting series, is living proof of what might have seemed an iffy proposition back in 2001, when the first film was made: track a trio of child actors who grow up in real time and mature along with their characters. But **Daniel Radcliffe** (Harry), **Emma Watson** (Hermione) and **Rupert Grint** (Ron) are all fascinating to watch as they grow up onscreen. ● *Hairspray*, the lovable tale of Tracy Turnblad, the plump girl who makes good in a 1962 dance-a-thon, is back.
