

Winnick moves from horror to more mind-bending fare in two upcoming features. First up is Radio Free Albemuth. In this film, she plays the wife of a man who has strange visions about a government conspiracy. In Cold Souls, she plays a mob-connected Russian actress who wants Oscar winner Al Pacino's soul to improve her acting chops but finds herself saddled with Oscar nominee Paul Giamatti's soul instead. But there's a hitch: Giamatti, who plays himself, wants it back! The movie was partly filmed in Russia, which meant that Winnick had to master some Russian lingo, but as usual she toughed it out.
